# Jet-setting with an iPhone

# 1. Getting started

- 1.1. Download an itinerary app
  - 1.1.1. Explore places to go
  - 1.1.2. Organize your itinerary and activities, share with others
  - 1.1.3. Email flight itinerary and reservations to the app
  - 1.1.4. Details can also appear in Calendar app
  - 1.1.5. Apps: Kayak, Triplt, Tripsy, App in the Air, Flighty, Flight Aware
  - 1.1.6. Other random travel apps/websites: lonelyplanet.com, Tripadvisor, ricksteves.com, Airbnb, Hostelworld, Expedia, Lounge Buddy, booking.com, trivago

#### 1.2. Book travel

- 1.2.1. Some travel apps include the ability to book airlines, hotels, and car rental
- 1.2.2. Track prices
- 1.2.3. Apps: Hopper, airline apps, hotel apps, car rental apps
- 1.3. Prepping your iPhone
  - 1.3.1. Charger and cables, headphones, external battery, plug adapters
  - 1.3.2. Turn on Find My (Settings > [Your Name] > Find My > Find My iPhone, turn on all three switches
  - 1.3.3. Turn on Backup (Settings > [Your Name] > iCloud > iCloud Backup, turn on Back Up This iPhone
- 1.4. Using the iPhone
  - 1.4.1. Check on cellular service
  - 1.4.2. Carrier plans overseas
  - 1.4.3. Avoid data roaming
  - 1.4.4. SIM card or eSIM
    - 1.4.4.1. Settings > General > About
    - 1.4.4.2. Check for existing SIMs and eSIMs
    - 1.4.4.3. Make sure iPhone is unlocked and can be used with other carriers

- 1.4.4.4. Get SIM or eSIM from local provider upon arrival
  - 1.4.4.4.1. Helpful links

- 1.4.4.5. Consider shutting off cellular data for things like podcasts, photos, video streaming
- 1.4.4.6. Consider creating accounts on other messaging services
  - 1.4.4.6.1. Apps: What's App, WeChat, Signal, Telegram
- 1.4.5. Consider a Virtual Private Network
  - 1.4.5.1. VPN software creates a secure encrypted tunnel through which your data travels on the internet
  - 1.4.5.2. Apps are free to download, generally require a subscription for the service
  - 1.4.5.3. Check the country where the VPN is located
  - 1.4.5.4. Review what data the VPN provider can access
  - 1.4.5.5. Turn VPN on in Settings or the VPN app
  - 1.4.5.6. Apps: Express VPN, Proton VPN

#### 2. Collaborate

- 2.1. Create folder in the Notes app for the trip and share it
  - 2.1.1. Tap Notes
  - 2.1.2. At the bottom of the folder list, tap New Folder button end and store it in iCloud
  - 2.1.3. Name the new folder
  - 2.1.4. Touch and hold the new folder in the folder list and tap Share Folder
  - 2.1.5. Pick a way to invite others to share the new folder (e.g., Messages, Mail)
  - 2.1.6. Send the invitation
  - 2.1.7. Use the Collaboration button 2 to manage the shared folder
- 2.2. Or create a single shared note
  - 2.2.1. Tap Notes
  - 2.2.2. Create a new note stored in iCloud [7]

- 2.2.3. Tap the Share button (1)
- 2.2.4. Pick a way to invite others to collaborate in the note (e.g., Messages, Mail)
- 2.2.5. Send the invitation
- 2.2.6. Use the Collaboration button 2 to manage the shared note
- 2.3. Create a Packing List in Reminders
  - 2.3.1. Tap Reminders
  - 2.3.2. Tap Add List
  - 2.3.3. Give the list a name, color, and icon
  - 2.3.4. Share the list with others
    - 2.3.4.1. Tap the list to open it
    - 2.3.4.2. Tap the Share button 🛈
    - 2.3.4.3. Pick a way to invite others to collaborate on the list (e.g., Messages, Mail)
    - 2.3.4.4. Send the invitation
    - 2.3.4.5. Use the Collaboration button 2 to manage the shared list
  - 2.3.5. Make it a template to use it for future travel
    - 2.3.5.1. Tap the list
    - 2.3.5.2. Tap More ⊙
    - 2.3.5.3. Tap Save as Template
- 2.4. Build a Bucket List
  - 2.4.1. Notes and Reminders can work for this
  - 2.4.2. Apple Maps Guides
    - 2.4.2.1. Open Maps
    - 2.4.2.2. Search for a point of interest
    - 2.4.2.3. Tap More **⊡**
    - 2.4.2.4. Tap Add to Guides
    - 2.4.2.5. Tap an existing guide, or tap New Guide, give the new guide a name, and tap Create
  - 2.4.3. Share a guide
    - 2.4.3.1. Open Maps
    - 2.4.3.2. Swipe up to see My Guides

- 2.4.3.3. Swipe right to left on a guide and tap Share
- 2.4.3.4. Pick a way to share the guide (e.g., Messages, Mail) and send it

## 3. Wallet and travel documents

- 3.1. Set up Apple Pay
  - 3.1.1. It's just about everywhere: <a href="https://support.apple.com/en-us/HT207957">https://support.apple.com/en-us/HT207957</a>
- 3.2. California Digital Vaccine Record: https://myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov/
- 3.3. Check in for your flight
  - 3.3.1. Use airline app
  - 3.3.2. Copy boarding pass to Apple Wallet
- 3.4. Other travel documents
  - 3.4.1. Photo of Passport, Global Entry, other ID cards in Photos app
  - Maybe place in Hidden Album, which requires Passcode/Touch ID/Face ID to view
  - 3.4.3. Can also add photos to a Note and lock the note for safe keeping
  - 3.4.4. Apps: Clear, MyTSA, Mobile Passport Control (simplify re-entry into the Unites States)

# 4. In-flight

- 4.1. Add content to iPhone so you won't need wi-fi
  - 4.1.1. Download 🗘 music, books, podcasts, movies, TV shows to iPhone
- 4.2. Airplane mode
  - 4.2.1. Disables wi-fi and cellular
  - 4.2.2. Open Control Center and tap → (or tap Settings and turn on Airplane Mode)
  - 4.2.3. Optionally, turn on wi-fi @ and/or cellular @ by tapping their icons

## 5. Getting around and getting by

- 5.1. Apps: Maps, Google Maps, Maps.Me, Uber, Lyft, Transit, City Mapper, local transit apps (trains, subway, etc.)
  - 5.1.1. Google Maps has download feature

- 5.1.1.1. Search for a location
- 5.1.1.2. Tap Download Offline Map
- 5.2. Language barrier?
  - 5.2.1. Translate app
    - 5.2.1.1. Settings > Translate
    - 5.2.1.2. Download languages in advance
    - 5.2.1.3. Optionally, choose on-device mode, which may be less accurate
    - 5.2.1.4. Apps: Translate, Google Translate, Converse
  - 5.2.2. Translate websites
    - 5.2.2.1. Open website in Safari in a foreign language (for example: <a href="https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/it">https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/it</a>)
    - 5.2.2.2. Tap AA button, then tap Translate to English
  - 5.2.3. Translate on the fly with LiveText
    - 5.2.3.1. Good for menus, signs, and other text (even handwriting)
    - 5.2.3.2. Settings > Camera
      - 5.2.3.2.1. Turn on Show Detected Text
    - 5.2.3.3. Tap Camera
    - 5.2.3.4. Point camera at text
    - 5.2.3.5. Yellow border will appear around text the camera recognizes
    - 5.2.3.6. Tap Live Text icon 🗐 in lower right-hand corner of frame
    - 5.2.3.7. Tap Select All to select all the text, or tap a word and drag the selection handles to select text
    - 5.2.3.8. In the menu above the selected text, tap > then tap Translate
    - 5.2.3.9. Tap Change Language to select the Original and Translation languages
  - 5.2.4. Conversions
    - 5.2.4.1. Apps: My Currency Converter, Unit Converter

#### 6. Photos

- 6.1. Create an album and put photos and videos in it
  - 6.1.1. Tap Albums

- 6.1.2. Tap Add +
- 6.1.3. Tap New Album
- 6.1.4. Give the album a name
- 6.1.5. Tap Library
- 6.1.6. Tap Select
- 6.1.7. Tap the photos you want to put in an album
- 6.1.8. Tap the Share button 🛈
- 6.1.9. Tap Add to Album
- 6.1.10. Tap the album to add the photos and videos, or create a new album
- 6.2. Create a shared album
  - 6.2.1. Tap Albums
  - 6.2.2. Tap Add +
  - 6.2.3. Tap New Shared Album
  - 6.2.4. Give the album a name and tap Next
  - 6.2.5. Invite people with whom you want to share the album and tap Create
  - 6.2.6. Tap the new shared album and then tap + to select items to put in the shared album
  - 6.2.7. Subscribers can like and comment on photos.
  - 6.2.8. Settings for shared albums
    - 6.2.8.1. Open a shared album
    - 6.2.8.2. Tap the Collaboration button 🚱
    - 6.2.8.3. Allow subscribers to post
    - 6.2.8.4. Allow non-Apple users to see the shared album on a webpage within your iCloud account
    - 6.2.8.5. Get notifications when subscribers like, comment on, or add items to the shared album
