 - 3.2.10.1. Set skip forward and skip back times, use headphone controls and car controls to move between chapters of an audiobook

4. Reading Now

- 4.1. Current and Recent books
 - 4.1.1. Symbols beneath the cover
 - 4.1.1.1. Cloud icon: Book is available for download; tap to download and open it
 - 4.1.1.2. More button: Many choices, including sharing information about it, removing it, adding to a collection, rate and review, etc.
 - 4.1.2. Tap the book to open it
 - 4.1.2.1. iPad portrait orientation: Shows one page
 - 4.1.2.2. iPad landscape orientation: Shows two pages
 - 4.1.2.3. Tap in the right or left margins to turn the page forward or back. Or swipe the screen.
 - 4.1.2.4. Tap the screen to see the Reading Menu; tap again to it
 - 4.1.2.5. Tap ⊗ to close the book and return to Reading Now
 - 4.1.2.5.1. Your place is saved automatically (no need for a bookmark) and synced through iCloud
 - 4.1.3. Reading Menu
 - 4.1.3.1. Tap the Contents button to see a Table of Contents

- 4.1.3.1.1. Drag the slider to move quickly through the book
- 4.1.3.2. Tap the Bookmarks & Highlights button see list of bookmarks you've set and content you've highlighted
 - 4.1.3.2.1. Tap a Bookmark or Highlight to go to it.
 - 4.1.3.2.2. Swipe left on a Bookmark or Highlight to delete it or share it
- 4.1.3.3. Tap the Search button to search for a word or page number
- 4.1.3.4. Tap the Themes and Settings button to change the look and feel of the book you are reading
 - 4.1.3.4.1. Pick a theme from among the six choices (Original, Quiet, Paper, Bold, Calm, and Focus)
 - 4.1.3.4.1.1. Tap Options to change the font and its style; to customize the line, character, and word spacing; apply Full Justification; and enable Multiple Columns.
 - 4.1.3.4.2. Tap the Font Size buttons to make the font larger or smaller
 - 4.1.3.4.3. Tap the Scrolling Pages button to read the book by scrolling vertically
 - 4.1.3.4.4. Tap the Page Animation button to switch between Slide, Curl, and None
 - 4.1.3.4.5. Tap the Dark Mode button to choose between Light, Dark, Match Device, or Match Surroundings
- 4.1.3.5. Tap the Share button to share details about the book
- 4.1.3.6. Tap the Bookmark button to set a bookmark

- 4.1.4. Touch and hold a word or and drag across text to select it and show a menu
 - 4.1.4.1. Look Up a definition
 - 4.1.4.2. Translate text
 - 4.1.4.3. Share the highlighted content
 - 4.1.4.4. Highlight
 - 4.1.4.4.1. Select a color or underline for the high-lighted content
 - 4.1.4.5. Add Note will highlight the selected content and open a window for a note
 - 4.1.4.5.1. A marker will appear in the book's margin; tap it to read the note
 - 4.1.4.6. Also highlight text and add a note later
 - 4.1.4.7. Tap highlighted text and tap Remove to remove it
- 4.1.5. Tap an image to see a larger view

 - 4.2.1. Add items here that you find in Book Store or in Library
