## Shazam

What's that song playing?

On your iPhone (or iPad), go to Settings->Control Center

Scroll down to the second section, More Controls.

Tap the plus sign (+) next to Music Recognition.

Now, once you go to your Control Center, you'll see the icon (blue Shazam "S" icon). Tap it, hold your phone near the speaker where the song is playing, and it will identify the song and push a notification to it. If you have Apple Music, you can then open it there, and add it to your library.
