
#### What is TextExpander?

- TextExpander is a text shortcut tool: Type something short and it expands into something long. Can use in any app.
- You could type something long and have it expand into something short, if you really want that.
- Example: I type "txp" and it expands into "TextExpander"
- TextExpander is great for hard to spell names, like...



## This Guy

- Been watching him my entire life
- Couldn't spell his name to save my life
- But I can type ;arnie to spell it out





### What is TextExpander? Continued

- TextExpander is great for long or hard to type Snippets of text, commands, phrases, GPT prompts, etc.
- The entire text of Hamlet, at your fingertips! .hamlet
- Customize with fill-ins, find Snippets with Inline Search, and share Snippets with others
- Highly secure: Compliant with SOC-2, GDPR, and CCPA
- Supports: Mac, Chrome, Windows, plus betas for iOS and Android



#### Benefits of TextExpander

- Less time spent on menial tasks—more time on what matters
- Imagine getting an extra day per year!
  - Peter van Teeseling of Dscoop saved over 27 hours in 2022
  - Middle school teacher Mark Phillips saved 18 hours in 2022
  - SketchUp's support team saves 2,160 hours annually
- Less RSI pain—less typing means less strain on forearms and wrists
  - o Dr. Melanie Hsu Children's Health Council
- Consistency—reduce typos, consistent messaging
  - "Be your best even on your worst days."
- Knowledge sharing—team accounts can automatically share Snippets
  - We use this internally to share customer support Snippets

#### TextExpander Basics

- Enough spiel, let's create a Snippet!
- Let's have NMUG expand to Naples Macfriends User Group
- Start by creating a Group
  - Groups are basically just folders to organize your Snippets
  - More Groups are better: Makes sorting and sharing easier
  - (TextExpander Best Practice): Keep related Snippets in the same Group!
- Making a Snippet
  - Label: The name of the Snippet
  - Abbreviation: What you type to expand the Snippet
  - Content: What the Snippet expands to
- Let's see it in action



#### **Essential Snippets**

- myname
- mytitle
- myemail
- myphone
- mysig
  - Trick: Embed the previous four Snippets into this Snippet!
  - Let's see how that works.
- Hard-to-type symbols
  - Degree symbol (xdegree)
  - o Emoji
- Dates
  - isodate



#### **Group Settings**

- Powerful things here, often the cause (and solution) to many common issues
- Notes: Great place to add documentation for peers and/or your future self (TextExpander Best Practice)
- Expand in: Can limit where Snippets expand
- Expand when: whitespace precedes is the default
  - May want to set to "any character," especially for URLs
- Group prefix
  - Abbreviation prefix applies to every Snippet in that Group
  - Powerful way to organize Snippets and make them memorable, but be careful!
  - If you move a Snippet out of a Group with a Group Prefix, it removes the Group Prefix from that Snippet!

### Snippet Abbreviation Strategies

- Abbreviations can be whatever string of text you want
- "Your scientists were so preoccupied with whether or not they could that they didn't stop to think if they should." — Dr. Ian Malcom
- We want abbreviations to be
  - Short
  - Easy to type
  - Hard to expand accidentally
  - Memorable
    - A lot of old-school Snippets look like ;diufewjldk
- Typically, we like to add a prefix to an abbreviation



#### Popular Abbreviation Prefixes

- Popular Prefixes
- Semicolon (;) easy to reach on the keyboard
- Dot or period (.) preferred by doctors used to Epic EHR dotphrases
- x easy to reach on a mobile keyboard, but easy to type by accident
- // often used for URLs and bookmarks
- Mnemonic prefixes
  - This is what we recommend longer but easy to remember and search
  - Calendar group cal.
  - o Email group: em.
  - This is where Group Prefixes shine.



#### Inline Search

- Many veteran TextExpander users don't know about this!
- Shortcuts:
  - macOS: Command + /
  - Windows: Control + /
  - Chrome: Control + Period
- Can search by abbreviation or label
- Turns TextExpander into a knowledge base for you or your whole team
- Great for Snippets you can't remember
- We use this in TextExpander customer support! Entire company has access to customer service solutions.

#### Advanced Features — Paste Plain Text

- Don't you hate it when you copy from one app, paste into another, and it includes the formatting from the first app?
- With TextExpander, you can insert the contents of your Clipboard.
- Set the Content Type to Plain Text
- My own Snippet for this: xpt
- Maybe my most commonly used Snippet
- Let's take a look...



#### Advanced Features — Fill-Ins

- Fill-ins let you customize your Snippets
- Single Line Field: Simple fill-in-the-blank
- Multi Line Field: Longer blank
- Optional Sections: Check or uncheck to include or exclude sections
- Popup Menu: Drop-down menu of options
- Example Snippet: devhist



#### Advanced Features — Keyboard Emulation

- TextExpander can emulate many common keyboard navigation keys
  - Enter
  - o Esc
  - Tab
  - Return
  - Tab
  - Arrow keys
- Useful for filling out forms
- Common use case: Create an email Snippet with the subject line, a tab, and then the body of the message
- Example Snippet: poweroutage



### TextExpander Pricing

- Try free for 30 days
